



## Career Connect Scholarship FAQs

### ***Why does CCYP have a scholarship fund?***

To give back to Cape Cod and the emerging workforce that is the future of this region. The Career Connect Program, in partnership with Cape Cod Foundation, creates local opportunities for local young professionals, who are truly the essence of Cape Cod's future.

### ***What is the purpose of the scholarship?***

For adult students (ages 21+) to return to school, train in a new profession, or to take courses to develop their professional life on Cape Cod.

### ***Who is eligible?***

Applicants MUST have resided on Cape Cod (Barnstable County) for the past three consecutive years, and may be attending classes either full-or part-time. Past recipients, CCYP board members and staff (as well as their immediate family members), are not eligible for this scholarship.

### ***What are the criteria?***

The review committee looks for students who embody the mission of CCYP – those who are connected and engaged in the community, and looking to advance their personal and professional lives on Cape Cod, as well as meet the needs of our region.

### ***Where does the funding come from?***
