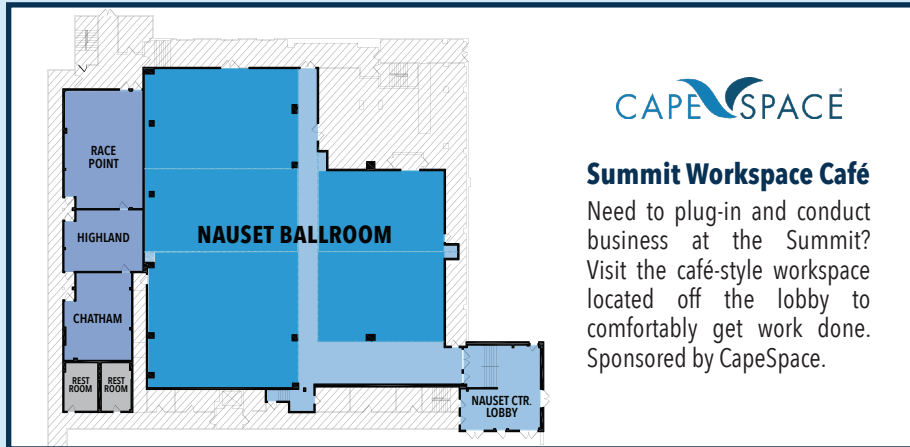


#CCYPSUMMIT LOCATION MAP
